### Images claimed to "show Turkish soldiers joining the Israeli Army"

The claim that the images shared on some social media accounts show "Turkish soldiers joining the Israeli army" **is not true**.






**TRUTH** | The individuals in the photo are not Turkish citizens.

It has been determined that the people in the mentioned photo are Israeli soldiers called Asaf Pinhas Tubul, Neriya Zisk, and vir David Fima, who died in the Gaza Strip in December 2023.

Unfounded claims should not be given credit.





### CLAIM: "President Erdoğan refused to transfer Ismail Haniyeh's fortune of approximately 3 billion dollars in Turkish banks to Haniyeh's sons"

The claim shared by Foreign Minister Israel Katz of Israel on his social media account that 'President Erdoğan refused to transfer Ismail Haniyeh's fortune of approximately 3 billion dollars in Turkish banks to Haniyeh's sons' is **false**.





**TRUTH** | Ismail Haniyeh, the head of the Hamas Political Bureau, who was martyred in Iran as a result of an Israeli assassination, did not have any savings in Turkish banks as claimed.

President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan received Haniyeh's sons Abdusselam and Hemmam Haniyeh and conveyed his condolences on Haniyeh's martyrdom.

During the meeting, no such issue was raised, as claimed by the Foreign Minister Katz of Israel.

Disinformation campaigns carried out by Israel to justify its genocide in Palestine and to manipulate the world public should not be given credit.








### Images claimed to show "the building where Hamas Political Bureau Chief Ismail Haniyeh was assassinated in Tehran"


The claim that the images circulating on certain social media accounts show "the site of the assassination of Hamas Political Bureau Chief Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran" is **false**.





**TRUTH** | Upon examining the said posts, it has been determined that the images were circulated in the media following the attack on April 1, 2024, on the Iranian Embassy in Damascus, Syria, which resulted in the deaths of many soldiers affiliated with the Iranian Revolutionary Guards.









### CLAIM: "Palestinians are being secretly brought to Türkiye, with all expenses covered by AFAD"

The claim covered by some media outlets and shared on social media that "Palestinians are being secretly brought to Türkiye, with all expenses covered by AFAD" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Due to Israel's brutal attacks on Gaza since October 7 and the resulting humanitarian crisis, Turkish citizens, citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), and severely ill Palestinian citizens along with their companions have been evacuated from the region and brought to our country.

The needs for food and shelter for cancer patients, kidney patients (those requiring dialysis), and other severely ill patients brought from Gaza, as well as those who have lost limbs, are being provided by AFAD in Istanbul and Ankara.

In this context, the humanitarian needs of a total of 1,938 individuals, including 1,143 in Istanbul and 795 in Ankara, are being met.

The costs of in-kind and cash humanitarian aid provided to these individuals are covered by the contributions of charitable citizens donating to the Palestine Relief Campaign.

Unfounded claims to manipulate the public should not be given credit.

Gazze'de 7 Ekim 2023 sonrasında yaşanan İsrail'in acımasızsaldırıları ve sonrasında gelişen insani kriz nedeniyle, Türk vatandaşları, KKTC vatandaşları ve ağır hastalıkları bulunan Filistin vatandaşları ile refakatçileri bölgeden tahliye edilerek ülkemize getirilmiştir.

Gazze'den getirilen kanser, böbrek (diyalize ihtiyaç duyan) vb. ağır hastalar ve refakatçileri ile uzuvlarını kaybetmiş kişilerin iaşe ve ibate ihtiyaçları AFAD tarafından İstanbul ve Ankara illerinde sağlanmaktadır. Bu kapsamda **İstanbul'da 1.143** ve **Ankara'da 795** kişi olmak üzere toplamda **1.938**kişinin insani ihtiyaçları karşılanmaktadır.

Bu kişilere yönelik yapılan ayni ve nakdi insani yardımların giderleri Filistin Yardım Kampanyası'na bağışta bulunan hayırsever vatandaşlarımızın destekleriyle karşılanmaktadır.

### Images claiming "The weapon of a person arrested in Al-Khalil was confiscated"


It has been found that the weapon in the photo posted on the IDF's official account with the claim, "The weapon of a person arrested in Al-Khalil was confiscated" **is not real.** 





**TRUTH** | The weapon in the photo in question, claimed to be a rifle, was discovered to be a toy available on several toy websites.

Israel's propaganda campaign to legitimze its genocide in Gaza and manipulate global public opinion should not be given credit.

### CLAIM: "Hamas members were targeted and hit at a location outside the safe zone"

The claim made by official Israeli sources regarding the strike on Rafah on May 26 that "Hamas members were targeted and hit at a location outside the safe zone" is **not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Contrary to what was claimed, the region shelled by occupying Israel on May 26 was a "safe zone" in Rafah that housed civilians seeking refuge from Israeli attacks, not a Hamas headquarters.

The IDF announced on its official account on May 6, 2024, that the safe zone in the al-Mawasi area has been expanded. The post stated that the occupation will extend from Deir al-Balah in the north to Blocks 2323, 2371, and 2360 in the south and east to the centre of Khan Younis city, as shown in the map below.

Israel called on civilians living in the eastern neighbourhoods of Rafah to "go to the safe zone". These announcements were made through SMS, phone calls and publications in Arabic.









On May 22, IDF Spokesperson Avichay Adraee declared that the coordinates were secure. Hence, Israel attacked the area to which civilians had been sent under the guise of a safe zone.

International organisations, including the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), have confirmed in statements that a large number of civilians were the target of Israeli attacks.

Amnesty International called the attack on the displaced Palestinian camp a "war crime" that should be investigated.

Furthermore, the footage captured shortly following the attack indicates that many civilians were targeted. Prime Minister Netanyahu of Israel described the attack in Rafah as a "tragic mistake" and admitted that civilians were hit.





Despite the International Court of Justice's injunction on May 24, 45 people were killed and 249 injured in an Israeli attack in Rafah. It was reported that 23 of those killed in the attack were women, children, and the elderly.

### CLAIM: Photo claimed to show "senior Hamas leader Muhammad Shabana, who was killed in Rafah"

The claim that a photograph circulating in the occupying Israel's media "shows senior Hamas leader Muhammad Shabana, who was killed in Rafah" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | It has been found that the individual in the photos is Egyptian journalist Mohamed Shabana, not the senior Hamas leader.

Slander campaign of occupying Israel to justify its attacks on Rafah should not be given credit.









## CLAIM: "Hamas members at an UNRWA facility opened fire on civilians"

Regarding footage shared by Israeli official accounts, the claim that "Hamas members at an UNRWA facility opened fire on civilians" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | In order to justify their attacks, the occupying Israeli forces, who are targeting aid organisations and their aid workers, serve footage of armed individuals acting with aid organisations with the claim that they are "Hamas members."

Contrary to Israel's claims, the people in the aforementioned footage are in charge of securing UNRWA-delivered humanitarian aid.

These security personnel are affiliated with the People's Protection Committees, which were established by civilian organisations and tribes to maintain public order among Gazans who have taken refuge in Rafah.

The Israeli media acknowledges that these are groups formed by tribes and civilians.

They were previously seen inspecting markets and guarding aid supplies entering Gaza. The bandanna on their heads reads "People's Protection Committee".





The claim that the footage depicts an armed person opening fire on the UNRWA facility or civilians in the area is not true either. Upon analysis of the footage, it was ascertained that the individual in question made an effort to disperse the crowd and evacuate the civilians in the area from the settlement without resorting to violence.

The UN Independent Audit Advisory Committee's (IAAC) report on UNRWA also refutes claims by Israeli authorities. The report clearly states that Israel has failed to provide evidence to back up its claims that UN staff members are linked to armed groups.

Francesca Albanese, the UN Special Rapporteur on Palestine, has also reported that Israel deliberately killed World Central Kitchen (WCK) workers involved in relief efforts in Gaza.

# CLAIM: "UN halves estimates of women and children killed in Gaza"

The claim that "UN halves estimates of women and children killed in Gaza," shared by Israeli official accounts and published in some media outlets, **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | According to data published by the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs on May 6, 2024, 34,735 Palestinians have been killed in Israeli attacks since October 7, 2023.

On May 8, 2024, the UN updated the death toll from Israel's attacks on Gaza to 34,844. They also added new data to the report based on the gender and age of those identified.


Contrary to the claims of Israeli officials, the United Nations has not halved the death toll in Gaza. The UN no longer releases data on the total number of women and children who have lost their lives, but rather the number of women and children whose names and identities have been fully documented.

Gaza's Ministry of Health, on the other hand, stated that the numbers of casualties were separated into "identified" and "unidentified" persons.

International organizations such as the UN and the World Health Organization (WHO) have confirmed that the Gaza Ministry of Health's figures are reliable.

# Claim: "Fake Images from Gaza"

Israel, continuing its genocide against the people of Gaza, has been using behind-the-scenes footage from various films or documentaries since October 7 to create the perception that "the images from Gaza are fake."





**TRUTH** | The latest two images circulated by propaganda accounts are being shared for a similar purpose.

 Upon examining posts made with similar claims last week, it was determined that one of the images was recorded on March 11, 2018, during the "Medical Awareness Day Activities" at the Faculty of Medicine at the Islamic University of Gaza.



The posts in question have no connection to Israel's attacks in Gaza, which have killed more than 35,000 Palestinians since October 7.





It has been identified that there is manipulation being carried out concerning products for which export registrations were made at customs prior to the date of the restriction decision on April 9, 2024.

Furthermore, the Ministry of Trade has included the shipment of 1,096 products to Israel under this restriction, including those through warehouses, free zones, temporary storage facilities, and transit trade.




**TRUTH** | As it is known, the Ministry of Trade announced that exports to Israel will be restricted as of April 9.

The fuel in question is not fuel sent to Israel but jet fuel purchased for Israeli civilian aircraft at airports in Turkish territory. All refuelled aircraft are passenger aircraft.

Disinformation campaigns that aim to exploit public sensitivities should not be given credit.

# CLAIM: "Palestinian gunmen opened fire on Gazan civilians near Kuwait Square"

The claim that "Palestinian gunmen opened fire on Gazan civilians near Kuwait Square," which was shared on the official social media accounts of the Israeli state and the Israeli Ministry of Foreign Affairs, **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Contrary to the claims of official Israeli sources, Euro-Med Human Rights Monitor determined that the footage was recorded approximately 2 kilometres away from the Kuwait Square area where the massacre occurred. It also discovered that the person in the video was attempting to move civilians away from an area where Israeli military vehicles were stationed.


According to the official Palestinian news agency WAFA, the Israeli army attacked the teams escorting aid in Kuwait Square, killing 23 Palestinians.

The bodies of many of the attack victims were examined, and it was found that they had been hit by 5.56x45 mm NATO bullets commonly used by Israeli forces.

# CLAIM: "Senior Turkish officials sent a message saying 'We want to improve relations with Israel"

The claim in the Israeli media that "Senior Turkish officials sent a message saying 'We want to improve relations with Israel'" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Due to Türkiye's justified reactions to Israel's crimes against humanity in Gaza, the Temporary Charge d'Affaires of our Embassy in Tel Aviv was invited to Israel's Ministry of Foreign Affairs on March 25, 2024.

The aforementioned meeting occurred on this occasion, and the claims made by the Israeli press in no way reflect the truth.

Türkiye did not propose, as claimed, "the two countries' ambassadors should return mutually."


According to the information received by Anadolu Agency correspondent, the Israeli Army Spokesperson's Unit admitted that the Palestinian who was killed by an armed unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) in the Zeytun neighbourhood was found to be carrying a bicycle, rather than a rocket launcher as initially claimed.

The Israeli Army Spokesperson's Unit claimed that the Israeli army mistook the individual carrying a bicycle for an individual holding a rocket launcher and that the decision to attack was based on an instant assessment of the situation, apologising for the "erroneous inference".




**TRUTH** | The latest report by Refugees International, a humanitarian organisation advocating for better assistance to displaced persons, refutes Israel's claims.

The report established that the provisional measures issued on January 26 by the International Court of Justice, ordering Israel to facilitate the provision of humanitarian assistance into Gaza to preclude the possibility of genocide, had not been implemented.

The data from the United Nations also contradicts the Israeli authorities' claim that "aid delivery has increased." According to the data, the average number of aid trucks delivered in February decreased by 50% compared to the preceding month.









Furthermore, Israel is blocking access to the north of Gaza by keeping critical crossings such as northern Erez and Al-Muntar closed.

UN officials warned that if no action was taken, widespread famine in Gaza would become almost inevitable.

Dr Ashraf Al-Qudra, the spokesperson for the Ministry of Health of Gaza, revealed in an announcement that dozens were believed to be 'dying silently' of starvation in Gaza without reaching hospitals.

Jamie McGoldrick, the UN's Humanitarian Coordinator for the Occupied Palestinian Territory, told journalists at UN Headquarters on Wednesday that children in Gaza were dying from hunger.

The latest statement issued by the UN World Food Programme informed the public that a 14-truck food convoy was turned back by the Israeli Defense Force after a three-hour wait at the Wadi Gaza checkpoint within southeast Gaza.

The Israeli army's blockage of aid entry into the region has been affirmed by every international organisation.



Many international media outlets have shared verified images of children's deaths with the global public. Israel's attacks on Gaza have killed 30,410 Palestinians, including at least 13,230 children, since October 7.

### CLAIM: "In the footage aired by Al Jazeera, a victim allegedly killed in Gaza opens and closes his eyes"

The claim made by Israel's propaganda accounts on social media that "In the footage aired by Al Jazeera, a victim allegedly killed in Gaza opens and closes his eyes" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | As a result of the attack by the occupying Israeli army, 112 Palestinians waiting for aid at the Nablusi Junction on Rashid Street in Gaza lost their lives and 760 people were injured.


In a statement released following the attack, Palestine Red Crescent Spokesperson Raed al-Nims indicated that they attempted to transport the dead and injured to the hospital, but the number exceeded the present ambulance and medical team capacity.

Images from the region reveal that injured civilians were transported to hospitals using a variety of vehicles, including oxcarts. Al Jazeera also released some photographs captured during these efforts, with the caption "An empty pickup truck was used to transport casualties to a nearby hospital."

As the title of the news suggests, "casualties" are being transported by a pickup truck. Furthermore, the photographs plainly show both casualties and civilians who have lost their lives. Therefore, those whose motions or facial expressions are noticed in the footage are injured.

The claim shared on the official social media accounts of the occupying Israeli army that "Dozens of Palestinians who swarmed aid trucks in Gaza died as a result of stampede and being run over by trucks" **is not true**.






**TRUTH** | The occupying Israeli army opened direct fire on civilians waiting for humanitarian aid at the Nablusi Junction on Rashid Street in the south of Gaza. While 760 people were injured as a result of the attack, 112 people have died so far.

Officials from organisations such as the United Nations (UN) and the Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor (Euro-Med), which monitor the humanitarian crisis in the region, confirmed that the Israeli army carried out the attack.

International news agencies and media organisations also reported that the Israeli army's attack killed dozens of Palestinians.

Israel, which has killed over 30 thousand Palestinians in Gaza since October 7, has employed disinformation campaigns to manipulate global public opinion; such disinformation should not be given credit.




**TRUTH** | Aaron Bushnell, 25, an activeduty member of the U.S. Air Force, set himself on fire in front of the Israeli Embassy in Washington on February 25, saying, "I will no longer be complicit in genocide."

Following the incident, certain propaganda accounts attempting to legitimise the genocide against the Palestinian people circulated a fake post allegedly shared on Reddit by Bushnell that read, "Palestine will be free when all the Jews are dead."

The investigations revealed that Bushnell did not share such a post on Reddit.

Israeli propaganda should not be given credit.





# CLAIM: "It was revealed that Abdel Rahim Abou Fanah, the Chairman of the Zakat Committee of Hamas, spent the donations in a hotel in Israel"

Regarding the video circulated by Israeli propaganda outlets, the claim that "It was revealed that Abdel Rahim Abou Fanah, the Chairman of the Zakat Committee of Hamas, spent the donations in a hotel in Israel" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Not only is the tape unverifiable, but the person referred to, Abdel Rahim Abou Fanah, is neither a member of Hamas in any position nor the "chairman of the Hamas Zakat Committee."

It has been found that the video in question, which is circulated as a recent development by some media outlets in our country, was shared in June 2021 on social media accounts that make Israeli propaganda and appeared in some media outlets that serve the same purpose.

Furthermore, the claims that Hamas leaders, whom Israel sought either dead or alive, were caught enjoying themselves in an Israeli hotel expose the manipulation.








Israel initially circulated the video in 2021, followed by the distribution of two documents titled "Statement by Hamas and the International Union of Muslim Scholars." The documents asserted that Hamas and the Union of Muslim Scholars both condemned the incident and issued condemnations of the alleged member. It was discovered, however, that the documents were forged and that neither Hamas nor the Union of Muslim Scholars issued a statement regarding the matter.





According to new images shared by the Palestinian Red Crescent on its social media accounts, Israel directly targeted an ambulance belonging to the Palestinian Red Crescent last week while transporting oxygen tanks from Nasser Hospital to Al-Amal Hospital, injuring healthcare workers.

The Palestinian Red Crescent reported that three patients receiving treatment at the hospital died after Israel blocked the entry of oxygen tanks to Al-Amal Hospital.

Israel's propaganda, which aims to manipulate global public opinion while brazenly attacking and looting ambulances should not be given credit.

Regarding some images shared on Israel's official and propaganda accounts on social media, the claim that "Israel is facilitating the transfer of humanitarian aid to Gaza," **is not true**.






**TRUTH** | When the photos in question were examined, it was discovered that the images depicted a relief truck sent to Ukrainians on several occasions during the Russia-Ukraine War, as well as a tent city in Moldova belonging to refugees fleeing Ukraine.

The photos have nothing to do with humanitarian aid that has arrived in the region in the aftermath of Israel's attacks on Gaza.

According to data from the Geneva-based Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor (Euro-Med), prior to Israel's attacks on Gaza, an average of 500 trucks entered the territory daily, but this number has now dropped to 100 trucks or even lower due to Israel's blockages and indiscriminate bombardment.







# CLAIM: "Hamas declared its surrender and demanded a ceasefire"

The claim shared by Israel's propaganda accounts on social media that "Hamas declared its surrender and demanded a ceasefire" **is not true**.



**TRUTH** | The statements in the alleged footage were found to be manipulated and taken from an interview with senior Hamas official Moussa Abu Marzouk on November 3, 2023.

Upon analyzing the footage, it was found that Marzouk did not make any statement regarding "the defeat of Hamas or their desire for a ceasefire."

In an interview released on November 3, 2023, Marzouk stated, "The military mobilisation in the West Bank is rising, and there are reports of approximately 130 martyrs there. Yesterday, there was a general strike throughout the West Bank, and I hope that this mobilization grows until the occupation is lifted. The level of action must be such that the Israelis are forced to ceasefire, whether it is in the West Bank and Al-Quds, with our brothers and sisters in the north or south. Otherwise, there will be massive civilian casualties. That is why a ceasefire is so desperately needed, especially now."











# CLAIM: "The tunnel under Bani Suhaila cemetery was used by senior Hamas officials, and the October 7 attacks were directed from there"

The claim shared on Israel's official social media accounts that "The tunnel under Bani Suhaila cemetery was used by senior Hamas officials, and the October 7 attacks were directed from there" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | In a post, the Israeli army shared information about a tunnel that they claim belongs to Hamas, stating that it has two entrances.

CNN correspondent Jeremy Diamond, who visited the area following the claims, reported that Israeli soldiers took him to two different tunnels instead of the one in question. Additionally, he mentioned that "CNN's satellite imagery surveys did not uncover any tunnel entrances in the cemetery."

Diamond further said that Israeli soldiers who promised to film the tunnel entrances failed to do so, and that Israeli army Major General Dan Goldfuss informed him, "This whole thing might collapse. You need to walk to the edge. It is not safe."

Diamond stated that the Israeli forces did not show them the cemetery section of the tunnels, claiming that "there was construction equipment in that section, that the structure was unstable and that there was a Hamas command centre under the cemetery."


The allegations about a photo shared by Israeli propaganda accounts, claiming that "aid to Gaza was delivered to Hamas" **are not true.** 





**TRUTH** | The person in uniform labelled "Hamas" in the photograph used as the basis for the allegation is not a member of Hamas, but a policeman trying to deliver aid to displaced Palestinians in the Rafah border area. It was determined that the photograph was shared on the social media accounts of the Rafah Police on January 10, 2024.

Israel, which prevents aid from entering the Gaza Strip, where a humanitarian catastrophe is taking place, spreads the propaganda that "Hamas is taking the aid" in response to the reactions of world public opinion. Israel tries to justify its attacks on aid organisations with this propaganda.







# CLAIM: Israeli tank commander "We never fire randomly, we detect enemy and hit them precisely"

The claim of a tank commander in his remarks to the Israeli media that "We never fire randomly, we detect the enemy and hit them precisely" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Figures indicate that Israel's attacks on Palestine, particularly in the Gaza Strip, are conducted without regard for the lives of civilians.

Since October 7th, the Israel's massacre has resulted in the deaths of over 24,000 Palestinians and the injuries of over 61,000 Palestinians. Women and children account for 70 percent of those killed in Israel's indiscriminate attacks and bombardments. In many Israeli attacks, civilians—including staff from relief organisations, medical professionals, and first responders—are occasionally and sometimes purposefully killed.

118 journalists have died as a result of Israeli attacks thus far while attempting to inform the international public about the situation in the region.

Hospitals, educational institutions, refugee camps, buildings of aid organisations, places of worship and historical and cultural sites have been bombed while people were inside, as confirmed by officials from Palestinian and numerous international organisations.

Israeli propaganda should not be given credit.











### CLAIM: "Hamas shot the woman"

Regarding a video showing a woman carrying a white flag being shot, the claim made by Israeli propaganda accounts that "Hamas shot the woman" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | On November 12, Israeli snipers shot Hala Rashid Abd al-Ati as she attempted to flee the al-Rimal neighbourhood of Israeli-occupied Gaza.

The individual who captured and relayed to the broadcaster the video of the shooting incident involving Abd al-Ati, a member of the crowd approaching from the road that leads to al-Wihda Street in Gaza City, did not want to be named.

Sarah Bassem Khres, Abd al-Ati's daughter, told Middle East Eye that Israeli forces besieged their neighbourhood and stationed tanks and snipers in the densely populated residential area. Khres said that Israeli soldiers then told them to leave the area right away, and when they did, her mother was shot.

In addition, on November 15, Israeli accounts shared photos showing al-Nasr Street (the street parallel to the road where Abd al-Ati was shot) surrounded by tanks and snipers.








**TRUTH** | Hassan-Nahoum said, in reference to the attack that claimed the lives of two people at the Holy Family Catholic Church, "There are no churches in Gaza, and there are no Christians since Hamas banished them all."

Gaza is home to one of the oldest Christian communities in the world. Palestinians would never consider banishing people due to their differing religious beliefs.

Since October 7, historic houses, mosques, churches, libraries, markets, and education facilities in Gaza have been subjected to Israeli shelling and air strikes. The claim made by Hassan-Nahoum is completely unfounded.





The most ancient church in Gaza, St. Porphyrios Greek Orthodox Church, which was constructed in 406 AD, was also bombed on October 19 during Israeli hostilities in Gaza. The church's nave sustained significant damage, whereas the administration building was entirely demolished. 20 Christian Gazans who had taken refuge in the church lost their lives. During the bombardment of Jibaliye, the Byzantine Church, built in 444 AD, and the Holy Family Catholic Church, founded by Father Jean Moretan in 1869, were partially demolished. The Baptist Church, founded in 1882 by the British Church Missionary Society, was the target of Israeli shelling on October 17, causing substantial damage to its outbuildings. Hundreds of civilians were killed in the compound, which included the National Baptist Hospital.





The 1,600-year-old ancient Saint Hilarion Monastery in the Tell Umm Amer area of the Gaza Strip was also damaged in the Israeli attacks.

Most recently, Israeli soldiers killed a Christian woman and her daughter, who had taken refuge in the Holy Family Catholic Church. Fifi Saba, whose sister is trapped in the Holy Family Church, said, "The Israelis shoot anything that moves. Those who took refuge in the church are afraid to even go to the toilet because these women were shot while trying to go to the toilet."

Having massacred more than 20,000 civilians in the Gaza Strip, Israel is also trying to wipe out Palestine's cultural heritage.










 The Israeli military and official statements assert that Hamas has constructed command and control centres and ammunition depots within an extensive network of underground tunnels. Since October 7, Israel has been indiscriminately bombing Gaza and has failed to find any underground ammunition depots or headquarters to persuade the world community.









 Israel has carried out aerial and ground attacks in Gaza to destroy civilian settlements, schools, refugee camps, and medical facilities, and has created a number of videos to justify these attacks. On December 12, the Israeli army raided the Kamal Adwan Hospital in Gaza and released footage of patients and medical staff, claiming that they were "Hamas members." However, members of the Kamal Adwan Hospital staff were among those shown in the footage being coerced into holding firearms.







Following that, another image was shared on Israel's official accounts, showing the neonatal intensive care unit of Kamal Adwan Hospital, and it was claimed that several bullets were recovered from a baby incubator and a gun was recovered from a baby warmer.

It is completely illogical that guns and a few bullets were stored in a baby incubator and a baby warmer rather than the ammunition depots in the kilometers-long tunnels that Israel claims.

The location of the gun, according to the footage, is completely incompatible with the logic of "quick access to weapons and ammunition in the event of a conflict."

The gun is shown in the video not when the top head cover of the baby warmer is opened (the part with the inspection lights and infrared radiant heater), but when it is removed. The fact that the pistol or ammunition came from a heater demonstrates that the editing was sloppy.

Do not give credit to images doctored by Israel to justify its attacks and massacres, which have sparked outrage in the international community.











### CLAIM: ""Palestinians are putting on a show"

Regarding a video shared by Israel's propaganda accounts, the claim that "Palestinians are putting on a show" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | It has been found that the aforementioned footage is outdated and was captured on October 10, 2015 in Hebron.

65-year-old Ziyad Abu Haleel, who attempted to stop Israeli soldiers from opening fire on Palestinian youngsters, is seen on the footage saying to the soldiers, "You should be ashamed," before collapsing.







# CLAIM: "Israel has received over 2,000 additional Jewish immigrants, including those from Arab and Islamic countries, since October 7"

The claim that "Israel has received over 2,000 additional Jewish immigrants, including those from Arab and Islamic countries, since October 7" in some "photographs" released by the official Arabic social media account of Israel **is manipulated**.





**TRUTH** | Citing officials of the Population and Immigration Authority, Israeli media claimed in a news story published on December 4 that hundreds of thousands of Israelis had left the country after the October 7 hostilities, in addition to thousands of foreign workers, refugees, and diplomats.

470,000 of the 600,000 Israelis who left for the holidays and stayed abroad until October 7 have reportedly returned so far, while approximately 370,000 Israelis left the country after October 7. Thus, the number of Israelis who did not return or leave the country due to the war is approximately half a million. During this period, it is stated that arrivals for settlement in Israel did not stop completely but decreased significantly.

To counteract the reported negative immigration data, Israel posted photos on its official social media accounts, claiming that "more than two thousand new Jews have arrived in the country since October 7, and among them are people from Arab and Islamic countries."

It has been determined that the photographs in question were taken when "Nefesh B'Nefesh," a Jewish organisation, brought 215 Jews from the United States and Canada to Israel in August 2023.






Therefore, the photographs do not represent "the Jews, some of whom have emigrated to Israel from Muslim countries since October 7."

**Note:** Israel resettles the majority of Jews who come to the country on occupied Palestinian land and in the homes of Palestinians whose homes it forcibly confiscates.











While the person, whose hands and eyes are tied, has Hebrew writing and emblems on his clothes, it is evident from his accent that he is not an Arabic speaker. At the end of the video, the individual allegedly being interrogated raises his thumbs to mark the end of the filming.


### Images shared with the claim that "the Israeli army captured a large number of Hamas members in Khan Younis"

Regarding some images shared by Israeli propaganda accounts on social media, the claim that "the Israeli army captured a large number of Hamas members in Khan Younis," is **not true**.





**TRUTH** | Israel has failed to provide any evidence that the detainees were "Hamas members". It has been found that the detentions were not carried out in Khan Younis in the southern Gaza Strip, as claimed, but in Beit Lahia, north of Jabalia in the north. In addition, the presence of journalist Diaa Al-Kahlot and his relatives among the detainees, the presence of elderly people and children, and Israeli media reports indicate that the detainees are civilians.





#### PRESIDENCY OF THE REPUBLIC OF TÜRKİYE Center for Countering Disinformation

Israeli war correspondent Itay Blumental has been identified as the source of the images in the Israeli media. It was found that Blumental shared the images with the caption, "A number of people who surrendered in the Gaza Strip were arrested by the IDF. It will now be checked whether any of these individuals are members of Hamas or Islamic Jihad." Israeli media also reported the images as "Palestinian men surrender to the IDF in the Jabalia region".

In response to this information, which contradicts the claim, an investigation into the detained Palestinians and the location of the detention was launched.







Journalists in the region reported that the Israeli army arrested Palestinian civilians who took refuge in a school in the northern Gaza Strip and forced them to remove their clothes.

In addition, the "Ulayyan Pharmacy", whose signboard is visible in the images, is located opposite Jabalia Refugee Camp and Al Foqa school.

Diaa Al-Kahlout, an Al-Araby reporter, was seen in the images among those who had their clothes stripped and their hands tied. The broadcaster confirmed that Kahlout was detained along with his siblings and relatives on Market Street in Beit Lahia. On December 7, Ramy Abdu, Chairman of the Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor (Euro-Med), based in Geneva, announced that the detainees were Palestinian civilians, including children as young as 15 and elderly people aged 60-65 (names provided). Israilsources did not provide any evidence that the detainees were Hamas members. In light of this information, it is understood that the detainees were not kept in Khan Younis in the south of the Gaza Strip, but in Jabalia - Beit Lahia in the north, and the detainees were civilians sheltering in camps and schools in the area.

#### Image of a Palestinian claimed to be an "armed Hamas member"


The claim that the people in the footage shared by Israeli propaganda accounts are "armed Hamas members" **is false**.





**TRUTH** Officials from the Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor and journalists in the region attested to the identity of the individual in the footage as Beit Lahia, northern Gaza Strip resident Moin Qeshta Al-Masry, owner of a small aluminium shop. The authorities stated that Al-Masry sought refuge in the Khalifa School like other civilians.

Civilians living in Gaza reported that Israeli soldiers raided the Khalifa School, a shelter for 7,000 Palestinians, and detained men over the age of 15.







It was also revealed that the footage shared on social media by Israel's propaganda accounts was not the same. In one, the alleged Hamas member is seen holding the gun in his right hand and the magazine in his left hand; in another, the gun is seen in his left hand and the magazine in his right hand.

This demonstrates that the footage was captured over and over again for ideal framing.

Israeli journalist-author Barak Ravid, who also serves as CNN's Political and Foreign Policy Analyst, deleted his posts after this detail was spotted.


According to UNWRA, the United Nations • (UN) agency for Palestinian refugees, approximately 1.9 million people-more than 85 percent of Gaza's population have been displaced since October 7. There are around 1.2 million Palestinians trying to live in 156 UNRWA shelters. The UN and 27 partner humanitarian organisations described the situation in Gaza as "catastrophic" in a joint statement released on December 7. Furthermore, it called for the expansion of humanitarian aid and an immediate cessation of hostilities in Gaza. In a historic moment for the UN, Secretary-General Antonio Guterres invoked Article 99 and urged the Security Council to intervene in order to prevent a humanitarian catastrophe in Gaza.










 The World Food Programme (WFP) has announced that the escalation of Israel's attacks has rendered it impossible to deliver supplies to the people facing starvation in the Gaza Strip. WFP Deputy Executive Director Carl Skau said, "With just a fraction of the needed food supplies coming in, a fatal absence of fuel, interruptions to communications systems, and no security for our staff or for the people we serve at food distributions, we cannot do our job."







The World Health Organisation (WHO) • announced that of the 36 hospitals operating in the Gaza Strip, only 18 were now operational; three of them could only provide basic first aid, and the remaining hospitals provided only partial services. It was reported that hospitals that were able to accept patients were trying to provide services well beyond their intended capacity. According to reports from the WHO, the humanitarian crisis is intensifying due to unprecedented attacks on the healthcare system, including 203 attacks targeting hospitals, ambulances, medical equipment, and the detention of healthcare workers.







Hence, according to all international institutions and organisations, the continuous Israeli bombardment that is indiscriminate of civilian settlements, hospitals, and educational institutions; detention of healthcare workers; energy cutoff by Israel; restrictions on humanitarian aid imposed by Israel; and the incapacitation of aid organisations due to bombardment are identified as the causes of the humanitarian crisis in the Gaza Strip.






### Images shared with the claim that "Palestinians are fabricating fake videos"

**TRUTH** | The claimed videos were discovered to have been recorded for entertainment purposes and distributed on social media platforms two years ago.





# CLAIM: Manipulative images shared with the phrase "the crib, one of the symbols of Hamas' attack on the Kibbutz"

The images released during the visit of Elon Musk, the owner of Tesla, SpaceX and social media platform X, to Israel have once again revealed Israel's propaganda. **Manipulation** was also detected in the images released during Elon Musk's visit, which included the phrase "the crib, one of the symbols of Hamas' attack on the Kibbutz".





**TRUTH** | A large number of empty shell casings can be seen in the crib shown to Musk. The footage captured on November 12 during the visit of former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie, on the other hand, does not include this detail.

It is claimed that "the crib was caught in the middle of a Hamas attack with a child inside." Upon analysing the footage, it was determined that the crib, which was filled with "empty shell casings from the attack," showed no signs of damage.









 In addition, the shell casings are 7.62x51 ammunition from the MG3, which is used as secondary armament (machine gun) in Merkava tanks. Inside the crib, parts of the ammunition belt (chain) used for the machine gun are evidently visible.







**TRUTH** | When the photograph subject to the claim was analysed, inconsistencies were detected in light projections Furthermore, it was discovered that the shot contains meaningless objects and strange distortions.


The shadows of the objects in the shot are incompatible with the objects, and the photograph's light balance appears unnatural. Some weapons' front sights and magazines are not compatible with the weapon's structure, nor are they oriented correctly.

Moreover, objects with pointy tips hung on the wall bear no resemblance to standard weapon ammunition.

Many other features, such as perspective distortion, indicate that the image was generated by artificial intelligence.













### CLAIM: "Hamas propaganda: A woman in Gaza sobs while holding a doll as if it were her baby"

The claim regarding the footage, which was shared by social media accounts promoting Israeli propaganda, that "Hamas propaganda: A woman in Gaza sobs while holding a doll as if it were her baby," **is untrue**.





**TRUTH** | The Israeli army announced the end of the "humanitarian pause" that began at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, November 24, and the resumption of attacks on Gaza.


The baby in the footage claimed to be a "doll" is five-month-old Mohammad al-Zahar, who was killed in one of the attacks today. Mohammad Majed from the Anadolu Agency (AA) reported that those who were embracing him as they bid him farewell were his mother, Asmahan Attia Al-Zahar and grandfather, Attia Abu Amra. Ali Jadallah from the AA also captured plenty of footage regarding the news story.

Abu Amra spoke to journalists in the region while holding the body of his 5-month-old grandson, Muhammad Al-Zahar, in al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital in Deir al-Balah, and the footage was reported as a confirmed news story by many media outlets.

As soon as the humanitarian pause ended, Israel declared Khan Younis, where northern Palestinians had sought refuge, to be a combat zone, despite earlier claims that it would have been a "safe zone".



**TRUTH** | It was determined that the alleged images were not up-to-date and were shared on social media platforms in January 2023 with the caption "The first flight of my life".








**TRUTH** On October 11, 2015, while Asraa Jabes was returning to Jerusalem in her vehicle, an explosion occurred in the gas cylinder, leading to the car catching fire. Jabes suffered third-degree burns on 60 percent of her body, including her face and hands.

Israeli authorities accused Jaabes of organizing a "terrorist" attack without any evidence and sentenced her to 11 years in prison.

Jaabes, who was imprisoned in Israel for 7 years, was freed within the scope of the prisoner exchange agreement with Hamas.







## CLAIM: "A Hamas headquarters is located beneath Al-Shifa Hospital"


The claim made by Israel that "a Hamas headquarters is located beneath Al-Shifa Hospital" is a form of propaganda designed to **manipulate** international public opinion.





**TRUTH** | Israel has expanded its attacks beyond civilian settlements in Gaza to include hospitals, which are operating under extreme conditions to treat the wounded.

On October 27, Netanyahu, the Prime Minister of Israel, released a series of digitally produced animated images that depicted the Hamas headquarters situated beneath Al-Shifa Hospital. Israel has not presented any substantiating arguments to Netenyahu's claim.







- According to Dr. Mads Gilbet, a Norwegian doctor with sixteen years of experience at Al-Shifa Hospital, the claims that "a headquarter is located beneath the hospital" are entirely baseless.
- Additionally, the Israeli military claimed this numerous times and on November 14 conducted an operation against Al-Shifa Hospital.








 Despite the passage of time, no evidence regarding Israel's, particularly Netanyahu's, headquarters claim has been presented. It has been determined that some of the images shared with the claim that it is a "tunnel on the land of Al-Shifa Hospital" include elevator shafts and others septic tanks.









 The Israeli army served some images with the claim that a "Hamas list was discovered in the basement," and it was determined that the paper in the images was a calendar.



- The Israeli army released additional footage of a bunker-like area on November 22 and claimed that it was the alleged headquarters.
- The images that were shared fail to match the depictions of the "multi-story headquarters" that were included in Netanyahu's post.






The images clearly demonstrate that there is no command centre, headquarters, or ammunition depot, as has been claimed for weeks. An Israeli soldier stated in the newly released images, "The tunnel's exit was sealed. A month ago, they anticipated our arrival here." However, until recently, Israel maintained the claim that a functioning headquarters was located beneath the Al-Shifa Hospital.








 In recent years, numerous articles in the Israeli press have reported that a bunker was constructed beneath Al-Shifa Hospital in 1983, when Gaza was still under Israeli control. Israel is thought to have bombed the hospital under the pretext that the bunker, which was constructed in 1983, was present.







 The lack of evidence by Israel to support its claims regarding "headquarters beneath the Al-Shifa Hospital" has been acknowledged by numerous international news organisations, including CNN and BBC.







#### CLAIM: "A Fox News reporter was caught in the attempted ambush while visiting the scene of the music festival massacre"

Fox News channel's news report claiming that "Our reporter was caught in the attempted ambush while visiting the scene of the music festival massacre" turned out to be a **fiction**.





**TRUTH** | Following the gunshots heard in the footage, a person, allegedly a member of Hamas, was detained with his clothes removed and blindfolded. However, when the rest of the footage was analyzed, it was found that the incident was staged by Israeli soldiers for the reporters.

In the subsequent footage, the alleged "Hamas member who came to the festival area and set up an ambush" was subsequently seen clothing among the trees.

This so-called ambush moment was covered and disseminated by numerous international media outlets.







#### CLAIM: "It has been proven that Hamas is producing rockets to launch at Israel with EU funds allocated for Gaza"


The claim made by Hungarian Government spokesperson Zoltan Kovacs that "It has been proven that Hamas is producing rockets to launch at Israel with EU funds allocated for Gaza" **is false**.





**TRUTH** | After October 7, the European Commission, the executive body of the European Union, launched an investigation on the EU's assistance to Palestine, and the results of the investigation were released on the official website on November 21.

According to the findings of the review, which followed a two-step approach, it was clearly stated that "There was no evidence indicating that assistance had been diverted for unintended purposes."







#### CLAIM: "Hamas opens fire on Gazan civilians trying to flee south"


The claim that "Hamas opens fire on Gazan civilians trying to flee south" in footage shared by Israeli propaganda accounts **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | The alleged footage was recorded by Motaz Azaiza, a content producer for the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), and posted on November 19 with the caption, "How it looks from the safe passing that Israel claims about. They opened fire at people."

In response to the accounts that manipulated the footage, Palestinian journalist Azaiza stated, "I was the one who recorded this, and the Israeli occupation forces were shooting at people to scare them and make them flee faster."









#### CLAIM: "Hamas killed 160 Palestinian children during the construction of tunnels in Gaza"

The claim shared on some social media accounts that "Hamas killed 160 Palestinian children during the construction of tunnels in Gaza" **is not true.** 






**TRUTH** | The news article cited as the basis for the allegations was published in 2014 on the website of Tablet magazine.

In 2014, 2,310 people lost their lives in Israel's attacks on Gaza.

The Israeli propaganda magazine Tablet also tried to manipulate the world public opinion reacting to the civilian deaths in Gaza with the news "Hamas is killing children".

In 2014, as it does today, Israel made many baseless claims to justify the massacre of civilians.







#### CLAIM: "These are distinguished members of Hamas"

Regarding a photo of a mass grave shared by Edy Cohen, one of Israel's well-known journalists, the claim that "These are distinguished members of Hamas" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Those who were injured or lost their lives in civilian settlements bombed by Israel in the Gaza Strip were taken to Shifa Hospital, and 110 bodies there were buried in the mass grave in Khan Younis.

On November 22, Al Jazeera released images from mass burials that included remains of women and children.

# CLAIM: "There is a celebration for the ceasefire declared in Gaza"

Regarding the photographs shared on various social media platforms, the claim that "there is a celebration for the ceasefire declared in Gaza" **is false**.





**TRUTH** | It has been found that the photographs in question depict the celebrationa in Gaza following the ceasefire declared following the conflicts that occurred 9 years ago.

Following the escalation of tensions that began on October 7, 2023, Israel's attacks on Gaza continue.


### CLAIM: "Pakistan is supplying 155 mm artillery shells to Israel"

The claim that "Pakistan is supplying 155 mm artillery shells to Israel", shared on some social media accounts and reported in the press, **is not true**.



**TRUTH** | In a press conference, Pakistan's Special Representative to the Prime Minister of Pakistan for Middle East, Tahir Mehmood Ashrafi, addressed the allegations by stating, "Pakistan does not and can never have any relationship with Israel. "Selling ammunition to Israel is a distant prospect for Pakistan, a country that has not engaged in any form of trade, not even selling an empty bottle."

Ashrafi declared that aid was sent to Gaza via Egypt and that steps were being taken to double the aid. Furthermore, it was ascertained that the images of 155 mm ammunition that were disseminated through social media platforms originated from the August 2023 news article detailing a "60 million dollar ammunition agreement between the Israeli defence company Elbit Systems and the Israeli army."







#### CLAIM: Video showing "2 Palestinian journalists killed by Israel"

Regarding a video shared by Israeli propaganda accounts, the claim that it shows "2 Palestinian journalists killed by Israel" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | The people in the alleged video are Syrian journalists Jamil al-Hasan and Muhammed al-Faisal working in northern Syria. It was found that the images were shared on Jamil al-Hassan's social media account on October 7.


Although Israeli propaganda accounts share this video of rocket fire to justify the killings of journalists, which sparked outrage throughout the world, the video has no connection with Gaza.

The Palestinian journalists killed in Israel's bomb attack on the Bureij Refugee Camp in the center of the Gaza Strip on November 18 are Sari Mansour and Hassouna Salim.

More than 60 journalists have lost their lives in Israeli attacks in Gaza since October 7.

# CLAIM: "Palestinian boy living in Canada makes chilling threat to Jewish people"


The claim regarding the images shared on certain social media accounts that a "Palestinian boy living in Canada makes chilling threat to Jewish people" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | After examining the images subject to the claim, it has been determined that the slogans shouted during the pro-Palestinian protests were neither Anti-Semitic nor threatening the Jews.

The child in the image was shouting, "Long live the Resistance! There is only one solution. Intifada (uprising – resistance), revolution!"







# CLAIM: "Israeli soldiers are assisting civilians in Gaza"

The elderly man in the image, which was shared on Israel's official accounts in order to create the impression that their "soldiers are assisting civilians in Gaza," was executed by Israeli forces.





**TRUTH** | Israel's official Arabic X account posted an image of Israeli soldiers helping a civilian with a note that the elderly should be treated with respect.

The elderly man in the image has been identified as a 74-year-old Gazan named Bashir Haji from the Al-Zaytoun neighbourhood in Gaza City.

Bashir Haji, one of the thousands of Gazans forcibly displaced by Israel to the south, was brutally executed by Israeli soldiers.

His son told Al-Arabiya television that he lost his family while travelling south and subsequently found his father shot in the head and back.

Hala Haji, the granddaughter of Bashir Haji, declared that Israeli soldiers had murdered the elderly man after observing the image being used as propaganda material in Israeli accounts.

The Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Network also reported that Israel was using an image of an elderly Gazan executed by Israel as propaganda.





**TRUTH** | It has been determined that the alleged footage belongs to an old transmitter centre in Sweden.

Unfounded claims should not be given credit.







# CLAIM: "Israeli army discovered a Hamas tunnel on the premises of Al-Shifa Hospital"


The claim regarding images shared on Israel's official accounts that the "Israeli army discovered a Hamas tunnel on the premises of Al-Shifa Hospital" **is false**.





**TRUTH** | Upon closer inspection of the photos in question, it was discovered that the entrance of the blown-up hole had a concrete cover and pipes.

As the image below demonstrates, the structure shown in the images claimed by Israel as the "Hamas tunnel" closely resembles a septic tank (well).







## CLAIM: "Israeli soldiers are taking care of newborn Palestinian babies at Al-Shifa Hospital in Gaza"

The claim that "Israeli soldiers are taking care of newborn Palestinian babies at Al-Shifa Hospital in Gaza" regarding a photo shared on Israel's official accounts **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | The photo in question was shared on November 8, 2023 on the social media account of a clinic in Rishon LeTsiyon with the caption "Fathers visiting their newborn babies."

It was also discovered that the photo was published in Israeli media with the caption, "Two reserve officers were able to take a few hours off yesterday to meet their newborn baby."

**TRUTH** | It was determined that medical equipment was used improperly in the footage and the accounts spreading Israeli propaganda shared the footage with the claim, "This is a Palestinian, and they are fabricating fake footage".

As a result of the investigation, it was found that the footage was obtained from a TV series and that the alleged scene had been criticized in the Malaysian media in 2019.













## CLAIM: "Hamas' missile hit civilians and 20 Palestinians died"




The claim regarding the footage shared on certain social media accounts that "Hamas clashes with Israel in Al-Shifa Hospital" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** It has been determined that the footage in question was recorded on August 14, 2013, at the field hospital in Rabaa al-Adawiya Square in Egypt.

In order to legitimise its attacks on hospitals, Israel has been spreading many unfounded claims that Hamas members are in hospitals.









## CLAIM: "New and longest Hamas tunnels from Gaza to Israel have been discovered"

The claim regarding the images shared on Israeli propaganda accounts that "New and longest Hamas tunnels from Gaza to Israel have been discovered" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | The first image subject to the allegation was determined to have been published in the Israeli media in 2014, with the caption "Israeli Army: Tunnels discovered near the border with the Gaza Strip do not belong to Hamas".

The second image was also released by the Israeli army in 2014, claiming "tunnels in Gaza", but no evidence was provided.

The Rafah Border Gate between Egypt and Gaza was closed to commercial crossings in 2007, and Palestinians turned to tunnels to meet their basic needs due to the Israeli blockade and the closure of the border gate. Israel destroyed the majority of these tunnels by flooding them with seawater.

Images of these tunnels have been widely circulated by Israel, with the claim that they are "terror tunnels."

### CLAIM: "A group of young people in France attacked three Israeli girls and it did not end well"

Regarding the images shared on some social media accounts, the claim that "A group of young people in France attacked three Israeli girls and it did not end well" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Since November 4, 2023, the images, which are clearly understood to be fictitious, have been disseminated on social media with various claims. Some FETO accounts had previously shared the same image with the claim that "Turkish youth were beaten up by Frenchmen at whom they made a pass".

Aside from the fact that the images are fictitious, there is no evidence that the people in them are Turkish or Israeli.

Unfounded claims should not be given credit.







# CLAIM: "The injured young Gazan in the hospital, to whom his mother ran, was not injured, and the images of his injuries were fabricated"

The claims regarding some of the images shared by Israel's official account that "the injured young Gazan in the hospital, to whom his mother ran, was not injured, and the images of his injuries were fabricated" **are not true**.





**TRUTH** | Israel's official accounts have previously posted footage from documentary shootings, short films and theaters, claiming that "Gazans are making fake videos".

Israel's official account posted a video of a woman rushing to her injured son in the hospital and young people removing the bandage from his head, claiming it was a "fake injury video."

When the footage is examined, it is clear that, contrary to what was claimed, the bandage on the young boy's head was removed to reassure his mother by demonstrating that "his wounds were not serious."







## CLAIM: "Hamas is attacking civilians trying to reach the safe zone"

The claim that "Hamas is attacking civilians trying to reach the safe zone" regarding the footage shared on Israel's official Arabic X account **is false.** 





**TRUTH** | It has been found that the official Israeli account distorted the words of a woman who spoke to a reporter of the Al Arabiya television channel in Gaza.

When the alleged footage was analysed, it was discovered that the Gazan woman did not make any statements about Hamas trying to prevent civilians from travelling south.

The woman was not referring to Hamas when she said, "They shot without aiming, and we continued walking," Instead, she was talking about Israeli soldiers who displaced civilians and forced them to travel south.

It was also determined that the following statements of the woman and the parts where the sound of Israeli bombardment could be heard while the footage was recorded were omitted from the footage shared by the Israeli account: "I am coming from the camp on the northern coast. The situation there is really severe. There were martyrs on the ground, and people's homes were bombed by air strikes. It was horrible."

## CLAIM: "Hamas attacked the hospital and stole our medications," says woman alleging to be a doctor at Al-Shifa Hospital"

The claims in some images shared by Israeli propaganda accounts, such as "I am a doctor at Al-Shifa Hospital. Hamas attacked the hospital and stole our medicines" **are not true.** 






**TRUTH** | The efforts of the woman in the photographs to show the stethoscope in her hand and the logo on the back drew attention, and information was gathered by contacting health organisations in the region.

According to information gathered from Al-Shifa Hospital by members of the press and regional healthcare organisations, the woman in the photographs circulated by Israel is not an employee of Al-Shifa. Many Al-Shifa Hospital doctors and nurses remarked that they had "never seen this person before."

It was also established that the woman's Arabic accent was poor and that she could not pronounce some Arabic sounds such as "ayn" and "he."







# CLAIM: "Al Jazeera's footage shows Hamas members inside the Indonesian Hospital"

The claim made by Israeli official accounts that "Al Jazeera's footage shows Hamas members inside the Indonesian Hospital" **is not true**.






**TRUTH** | The area around the Indonesian Hospital in Gaza was bombed by Israeli warplanes, and civilians were reported injured as a result of the attack.

During the chaos inside the hospital, an individual was seen hitting the wall with a baton-like object in his hand.

Israel's official accounts tried to legitimise the hospital attacks by sharing images implying that this object was a weapon.

When the images in question are examined, it is clearly understood that the object in question is not a weapon.

**TRUTH** | Sean O'Callaghan, Assistant Chief Constable of the British Transport Police, stated that two separate offences were reported to the British Transport Police in relation to an incident at Edinburgh Waverley Station on Saturday, November 4.


The first reported incident is not linked to the protest at the station, and a 41-yearold man from North Lanarkshire has been arrested in connection with this incident, according to the statement.

Following the second report, which claimed that "demonstrators attacked a man selling a souvenir poppy," it was stated that detectives had thoroughly reviewed CCTV footage and spoken with witnesses identified.

As a result, it was announced that there was insufficient evidence to take the investigation further and that there was no reason to believe that poppy sellers were intentionally targeted.


The claim "the man in the body bag in Palestine sneezed" made through footage circulating on certain social media accounts **is false.** 





**TRUTH** | The claimed footage was taken from an Israeli TV show called "A Wonderful Country," which made fun of the Palestinian people's ongoing struggle.

Humorously depicted in this programme are corpses laid out side by side and wounded people lying in hospital beds.





# CLAIM: "Palestinians make children smell opiumlike substances and render them unconscious, then apply make-up and display the images to the world"

The claim with regard to some images shared on social media that "Palestinians make children smell opium-like substances and render them unconscious. Then they apply make-up and display the images to the world" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | On November 8, the Israeli army attacked Maghazi and Nuseirat Refugee Camps in the Gaza Strip, killing 35 people. Eighteen people, including 10 children, were killed in a targeted building.

Upon closer examination of the image, it became evident that the woman who allegedly applied make-up to the children was seen to be caressing the face of and saying goodbye to a child who died in the attack.

It was also determined that the object seen in her hand was a dhikr rather than a makeup item.











The Aflaj Irrigation Systems of Oman are ancient water canals built around 500 AD. There are about 3,000 underground irrigation systems currently in use in Oman.





CLAIM: Image shared on some social media accounts with the caption "North Korea's implicit message to Israel: Adolf Hitler's portrait was hung in the parliament"

Regarding a photograph shared on some social media accounts, the claim that "North Korea's implicit message to Israel: Adolf Hitler's photo was hung in the parliament" **is not true.** 






**TRUTH** | It has been discovered that the image of Adolf Hitler was montaged onto the claimed photograph.

The original photograph was taken by North Korea's official Korean Central News Agency (KNS) on March 31, 2013, during the plenary session of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of North Korea.

The unedited version of the photograph features Kim Jong II, the former ruler of North Korea until 2011, in the background.











Diplomatic sources from Türkiye and the US stated that "the protection of civilians, the facilitation of humanitarian aid delivery to Gaza's civilian population and the prevention of the displacement of people living in Gaza" were discussed during the meeting. Furthermore, Blinken has not made any statements as alleged. Unfounded claims should not be given credit.



#### CLAIM: "The ambulances we hit at the entrance of Al-Shifa Hospital were transporting Hamas militants. We killed many Hamas members during the attack"

The claim made by the Israeli Army Spokesperson on FOX News that "The ambulances we hit at the entrance of Al-Shifa Hospital were transporting Hamas militants. We killed many Hamas members during the attack" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Israeli forces, which indiscriminately bomb hospitals, schools, and civilian settlements, recently targeted the Al-Shifa Hospital, which houses tens of thousands of civilians, claiming that "Hamas has a command centre" beneath the Al-Shifa Hospital. Although they try to justify this claim using digital images and audio recordings of unknown origin, Israel has not proven it.

13 individuals were killed and 26 others were injured when the entrance to the Al-Shifa Hospital compound was bombed by Israeli warplanes on November 4.

This time, the Israeli army has claimed that the ambulances present at the hospital entrance were transporting Hamas members.

The images provided by international media outlets after the attack, as well as statements made by international organisations, confirm that civilians were clearly targeted in the Al-Shifa Hospital attack.





Director-General of the World Health Organisation (WHO) Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus: "Utterly shocked by reports of attacks on ambulances evacuating patients close to Al-Shifa hospital in Gaza, leading to deaths, injuries and damage."

President of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, Francesco Rocca: "These scenes are unacceptable. Civilians, ambulances, doctors, hospitals must be protected. Always."

United Nations (UN) Secretary-General António Guterres: "I am horrified by the reported attack in Gaza on an ambulance convoy outside Al Shifa hospital.

Images of bodies strewn on street outside hospital are harrowing."











### CLAIM: "IDF attack dogs go after Hamas militants inside tunnels in the Gaza Strip"

The claim made by Ofir Gendelman, spokesperson for Israeli Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu, that "IDF attack dogs go after Hamas militants inside tunnels in the Gaza Strip" **is manipulation**.





**TRUTH** | Upon analysing the claimed footage, it becomes apparent that it is actually a training video.

Even though the camera's movement on the dog's back creates the impression of a struggle, the person who was supposedly attacked does not react. Despite having one arm free, he chooses not to use his weapon.

Based on the person's arm width, it appears that there is possibly a dog-training sleeve concealed beneath the camouflage.

It is evident that the person's effortless actions do not match the sounds he makes.









### CLAIM: "Living people in Gaza are wrapped in shrouds, pretending to be dead"



**TRUTH** | The images in question were identified as having been shared on social media platforms on August 19 and were a part of the funeral procedures training given in a mosque in Malaysia.











The claim regarding the video shared on some social media accounts that "Pro-Palestinian protesters set a police officer on fire in London" **is false**.





**TRUTH** | The alleged video was recorded during protests that took place in the city of Guadalajara, located in the Mexican state of Jalisco, in 2020.

After the police detained 30-year-old Giovanni Lopez and he was later found dead, protests erupted throughout the country. During these protests, a police officer was set on fire.

The video has nothing to do with the claims.









### CLAIM: "Israeli forces shot a Hamas fighter like this"



**TRUTH** | The soldier in the video in question has been identified as an Iraqi soldier who was shot during clashes with the terrorist organisation DAESH.

## CLAIM: Lionel Messi expressed his support for Israel by carrying the Israeli flag

Claims that Lionel Messi expressed his support for Israel by carrying the Israeli flag **are not true**.





**TRUTH** | The screenshot that was disseminated by users of social media was found to have been altered. The social media accounts of the Argentine football player did not contain any such content.

It was found that Messi was holding a bag bearing a brand's logo and the image was altered to include the Israeli flag.









#### CLAIM: "We did not use white phosphorus bombs in Gaza"

Israel's claim that "we did not use 'white phosphorus bombs' in Gaza" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | According to the Palestinian Foreign Ministry, Israel deployed white phosphorus bombs in its attacks on civilian areas in the Gaza Strip, but the Israeli military refuted the claims, saying, "We have no information."


Following the reports of the journalists in the region, Human Rights Watch confirmed that Israel used white phosphorus bombs in Gaza and Lebanon.

Amnesty International also reported that the Israeli army deployed white phosphorus bombs indiscriminately in an attack on the southern Lebanese village of Dhayra on October 16, and this should be investigated as a war crime.

"It is beyond horrific that the Israeli army has indiscriminately used white phosphorus in violation of international humanitarian law," said Aya Majzoub, Deputy Regional Director for the Middle East and North Africa at Amnesty International.











#### CLAIM: "These are the teeth of children tortured, dismembered and burned to death by Hamas"

The claim that "These are the teeth of children tortured, dismembered and burned to death by Hamas" regarding the photographs shared by the Israeli Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Israeli state accounts **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Experts who analysed the photographs subject to the claim have determined that the teeth whose roots are visible are not children's teeth based on their root structure and size.

"When the crown and root morphology of the teeth seen here are analysed, it is plainly understood that these are adult teeth. In addition, bridge prostheses is not a method applied on deciduous teeth, and it is evident that the adult teeth seen in the photographs were prepared for crownbridge treatment."







# CLAIM: "President Erdoğan received the Courage to Care Award"

The claim that "President Erdoğan received the Courage to Care Award" is **manipulation**.





**TRUTH** | The images used as the basis of the allegation, which have been circulating for years and resurfaced due to the Israeli attacks on Palestine, clearly show manipulation.

The "Courage to Care Award", given by the Anti-Defamation League - ADL, is an award given to honour the rescuers of Jews during the Holocaust.

Therefore, the award was given in recognition of the efforts of Turkish diplomats who rescued Jews from genocide during the Holocaust (1933-1945), rather than being personally awarded to President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan.


In 2014, when speaking to the Turkish press about the controversial footage, ADL officials said: "We presented this plaque to the Prime Minister, but it was actually given to honour Turkish diplomats who have passed away."

In 2011, the award was named after Polish diplomat Jan Karski, who served as a soldier during World War II.

The photographs shared to create the perception that "There is no attack against civilians, people are swimming in the sea and having fun in Gaza", were actually captured on October 29 when Gazans, whose water and electricity were cut off by Israel, used sea water for cleaning purposes.

The photos were released by AFP with the caption: "Palestinians washing their clothes, dishes and bathing with sea water due to the lack of fresh water and electricity, on Deir Al-Balah beach in the southern Gaza Strip on October 29, 2023."











International Humanitarian Organisations rely heavily on inter-institutional cooperation.

The Turkish Red Crescent assisted the Palestinian Red Crescent during the construction phase of the facility, then handed over the keys and control. Neither AFAD nor the Turkish Red Crescent has a logistic warehouse or building in Gaza. Unfounded claims should not be given credit.





**TRUTH** | The images subject to the claim were analysed, and searches were conducted taking the distinctive characteristics of the building into consideration. The research revealed that the building in the images is the "Tanani Chalet".

Based on the address listed on Tanani Chalet's social media accounts, the location of the building was determined to be seven kilometres from the city centre of Gaza, in an area where summer homes are located near the sea in the northwest of the Gaza Strip.



Anwar Gargash, advisor to the UAE President, also stated that Reem Al Hashimy's remarks on Gaza and Israel were cut and misrepresented.









# CLAIM: "Hamas' propaganda: the same child in 3 different locations"

The claim "Hamas' propaganda: the same child in 3 different locations" regarding the photographs shared on some social media accounts **is false.** 





**TRUTH** | The photo was captured immediately following a bombing in Syria, not Gaza. On August 27, 2016, regime aircraft repeatedly dropped barrel bombs on the Maadi district of eastern Aleppo. A child who survived the bombardment, in which 15 civilians were killed, was carried hand-over-hand to the ambulance as an AFP photojournalist took photographs.

The Israeli bombardment that began on October 7 has claimed the lives of 7,700 people, including 3,600 children, and injured 19,734 others. Israeli attacks killed 500 healthcare workers, 25 journalists, and 38 United Nations workers.



The claim shared by the official Israeli state account and Hananya Naftali, the former digital media officer of Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, that "A Palestinian blogger miraculously recovered within a day after an Israeli bombing" **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Israeli propaganda accounts claimed that the clips were captured one day apart and that the same individual appeared in both clips to create the impression that "Palestinians created fake footage."

In the clip on the left, Saleh Aljafarawi, a Palestinian YouTuber and singer, has been identified as the person walking among the destroyed buildings. The person on the right (lying on a hospital bed) has been identified as 16-year-old Mohammed Zendiq, who lost a leg during an Israeli bombing on July 24.

While the official account of the state of Israel has deleted the post, accounts such as Hananya Naftali, who led the disinformation campaign, have not.



The claim that "Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh said, 'We would like to see Diyarbakir free''' **does not reflect the truth.** 



**TRUTH** | In 2012, then-Prime Minister of the Palestinian Authority in Gaza, Ismail Haniyeh, visited Türkiye and conferred with party leaders. In this context, Haniyeh met with Republican People's Party (CHP) Chairman Kemal Kılıçdaroğlu, Nationalist Movement Party (MHP) Chairman Devlet Bahçeli, Peace and Democracy Party (BDP) Chairman Selahattin Demirtaş and Felicity Party Chairman Mustafa Kamalak.

After Haniyeh's meeting with Demirtaş, claims were made that "Haniyeh said 'We would like to see Diyarbakır free'''. However, no arguments were presented to support the claim.

Speaking to Anadolu Agency about the claims, Haniyeh said, "During my meeting with party leaders in Ankara, I did not say anything that concerns Türkiye's internal affairs in any shape or form." Haniyeh stated that he 'did not utter such words or similar expressions and that the only agenda item of the meetings was the Palestinian issue.'





It was identified that the Typhoon fighter jets flying in the region last night took off from the UK-controlled military bases in Akrotiri and Dhekelia in Southern Cyprus and returned to the base from which they took off after patrol flights in the Eastern Mediterranean.

**TRUTH** | According to the most recent statement from US Vice President Kamala Harris, the armed attack in Lewiston, Maine, killed 18 people and injured 13.







**TRUTH** | It has been found that the alleged images appeared in the media on June 28, 2022, and are the images of the US 101st Airborne Division soldiers arriving at Romania's Mihail Kogălnniceanu Airport as part of the mission to strengthen NATO's eastern flank.







# CLAIM: "Humanitarian aid going to Gaza is being stolen by Hamas."

US Department of State Arabic language Spokesperson Samuel Werberg's claim that "Humanitarian aid going to Gaza is being stolen by Hamas" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | Al Jazeera Mubasher TV presenter Ahmed Taha asked Samuel Werberg "whether there is any information or document to prove his claim", but Werberg could not support his claim.

Humanitarian aid entering Gaza is stored and distributed by UN agencies.


The statement of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) on October 23 refutes Werberg's claims.

Aid entering Gaza is under the control of UNRWA, not Hamas. The agency's announcement noted that 54 trucks of aid were received by UNRWA teams upon reaching Gaza and aid materials were stored and distributed in cooperation with other UN agencies.













## CLAIM: "The UN said it did not check the trucks that entered the Gaza Strip."

The claim "The UN said it did not check the trucks that entered the Gaza Strip. How do we know that this is humanitarian aid and not more rockets for Hamas?" which was shared on some social media accounts **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | Research into the matter revealed that the disinformation was based on a news false news piece reported by the New York Times newspaper.

In an article dated October 21; the newspaper cited United Nations (UN) Spokesperson Stéphane Dujarric as saying, "20 trucks that passed through the Rafah border gate were not checked for weapons or other contraband."


The newspaper then published a correction stating, "An earlier version of this article misquoted Stéphane Dujarric, the chief spokesman for the U.N. secretary general's office. Mr. Dujarric did not say the first aid convoy that crossed from Egypt into Gaza had not been inspected for weapons."

In addition, Israeli officials announced that aid trucks were thoroughly inspected before entering Gaza.

# CLAIM: "Israel did not bomb St. Porphyrius Church in Gaza."

The claim by Edi Cohen, a well-known Israeli journalist, that "France24's investigation concluded that Israel did not bomb any Christian churches in Gaza" is **manipulation**.





**TRUTH** | When the news item cited by Cohen as the basis for his claim was examined, it was discovered that the news item claiming that St. Porphyrius Church was not bombed was broadcast on October 11 by France 24.


On October 11, the France 24 TV channel denied social media users' claims that the "St. Porphyrius Orthodox Church was bombed" and confirmed that the church was not damaged but clarified that there were bombings in various residential areas and near schools.

On the other hand, Israeli warplanes bombed the Porphyrius Church on Thursday, October 19. Therefore France 24's report is from about nine days before the church bombing.

Following the bombing of the Porphyrius Church, the Greek Orthodox Patriarchate of Jerusalem issued a statement condemning Israel's attack on the church in Gaza. The Patriarchate emphasised in a statement that the targeting of churches, which have become a safe haven for civilians, is a war crime that cannot be ignored.






**TRUTH** | The alleged videos were recorded in Iraq in 2016. Following the discovery of camera recordings from the surrounding area, it was found that an explosion in Iraq, which was covered in the news, was a fabrication.



**TRUTH** | The alleged video was recorded during a 2017 interview with Iraqi Member of Parliament Vian Dakhil, talking about women who were kidnapped by the terrorist organisation Daesh.

The statements in the video have nothing to do with the Israel-Palestine conflict.



**TRUTH** | Those seen clashing with police in the purported video are not pro-Palestinian protestors, but rather those opposing the Covid-19 quarantine in Barcelona, Spain, in November 2020.









### CLAIM: "Palestinians are making propaganda with a doll"

The claim that "Palestinians are making propaganda with a doll", in reference to the footage of children who died as a result of the Israeli bombardment of Gaza, **is not true**.





**TRUTH** | When the footage of what happened before and after the video subject to the claim was examined, the body was identified as belonging to a Gazan child who died in the Israeli bombardment.

Many media outlets and journalists in the region have provided verified footage of the child's death.

Palestinian journalists report that the body in the footage is that of a 4-year-old child of the al-Banna family from the al-Zaytoun neighbourhood in northern Gaza, which was bombed.













### CLAIM: "Hamas, not Israel, carried out the attack" on the al-Ahli Baptist Hospital in Gaza's al-Zaytoun neighbourhood"

The claim that "Hamas, not Israel, carried out the attack" on the al-Ahli Baptist Hospital in Gaza's al-Zaytoun neighbourhood **is false**.





**TRUTH** | The al-Zaytoun neighbourhood in the north of Gaza is an area where hundreds of civilians have been killed in days of intense Israeli bombardment.







The images that were recently posted by Israel's official state account on social media with the caption "We have evidence for those who still question what happened at the hospital in Gaza" **include manipulation**.





**TRUTH** | It was discovered that the video had been edited with manipulative intentions by cropping and reversing it before being shared. Upon analysing the unedited footage, it was concluded that the missiles launched from Gaza were aimed towards Israel, and the hospital that was struck was not in the path of those missiles.

**TRUTH** | The aforementioned footage was discovered to be from the demonstrations held on May 10, 2021, to protest Israeli security forces' attacks on the Al-Aqsa Mosque.

On May 7, 2021, Israeli police used stun grenades and rubber bullets against the worshippers at Al-Aqsa Mosque in al-Quds, resulting in at least 205 Palestinians being injured during the clashes. Citizens gathered under the leadership of nongovernmental organisations to protest the Israeli attacks.









# CLAIM: "1,671 Israeli asylum seekers fleeing the war arrived by ship in Alanya."

Regarding the images shared on certain social media accounts, the claim that "1,671 Israeli asylum seekers fleeing the war arrived by ship in Alanya" **is false**.





**TRUTH** | Cruise ships carrying citizens from various countries frequently visit Antalya and the Alanya region.

The footage shows tourists disembarking from a cruise ship that arrived in Alanya on October 6. The footage, recorded during a routine tourist trip, has nothing to do with the tension between Israel and Palestine.









# CLAIM: "Egyptian police opened fire on a large number of Israelis fleeing to Egypt from Israel."

Regarding some images shared on social media, the claim that "Egyptian police opened fire on a large number of Israelis fleeing to Egypt from Israel" **is not true.** 





**TRUTH** | The alleged video shows a clash near Ashkelon between Israeli forces and fighters from the Izz ad-Din al-Qassam Brigades, the armed wing of Hamas.

When the video is analysed, it is evident that the soldiers clashing on the road are Israeli troops. The alleged video has nothing to do with the attack in Egypt that resulted in the deaths of three people. (A police officer opened fire on a group of tourists in a protected site in Alexandria, Egypt, and as a result of the attack, two Israeli tourists and an Egyptian tour guide died.)










### CLAIM: "A police officer in Egypt opened fire at a bus carrying Israelis. 6 people were killed, and 8 were injured."

The claim shared on some social media accounts that "a police officer in Egypt opened fire at a bus carrying Israelis. 6 people were killed and 8 were injured" **is not true.** 



**TRUTH** | The Egyptian Ministry of Internal Affairs announced that a police officer on duty at a protected site in the city of Alexandria opened fire at random on a group of Israeli tourists, killing two Israeli tourists and an Egyptian tour guide. The statement indicated that the attacker was captured.

Israeli media, citing the Israeli Foreign Ministry, also reported that 2 Israeli tourists and an Egyptian tour guide were killed.







# CLAIM: "Palestine printed a stamp to support the socalled Armenian genocide."


Regarding the image of a postage stamp shared on some social media accounts, the claim that "Palestine printed a stamp to support the so-called Armenian genocide claims" **is not true.** 



**TRUTH** | Similar allegations have previously been made regarding the alleged image of the postage stamp. The Palestinian authorities have categorically denied the allegations, stating that Palestine has never issued such a stamp. The authorities explained that the postage stamp was created digitally and that similar postage stamps have never been issued in Palestine.

Some Armenian websites that sell thematic greeting cards and postage stamps have also been found to include the following statements about the alleged image: "We have received confirmation from the Palestinian postal authorities that the image shown here is 'not an official stamp of Palestine".










# CLAIM: "The Israeli flag was projected on some buildings in Azerbaijan."

The images shared on some social media accounts with the claim that "the Israeli flag was projected on some buildings in Azerbaijan" **are outdated**.





**TRUTH** | 50 countries participated in the "Baku 2015 First European Games", hosted by Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, in June 2015. The flags of the participating countries were projected on the Flame Towers in Baku. The alleged photograph was taken during this event.







# CLAIM: "Hamas forces took a young Israeli woman hostage."

Regarding the video shared on certain social media accounts, the claim that "Hamas forces took a young Israeli woman hostage" **is not true.** 





#### **TRUTH** | The woman in the alleged video is a Palestinian social media influencer known as "Rosey," who is being removed from the area while trying to film.
